Prayer Theme for March

We invite you to read and pray through Psalm 36:1-9 ten times in March. Below are some ways of interacting with the Lord as you do so.

¹ I have a message from God in my heart concerning the sinfulness of the wicked: There is no fear of God before their Eyes.
² In their own eyes they flatter themselves too much to detect or hate their sin.
³ The words of their mouths are wicked and deceitful; they fail to act wisely or do good.
⁴ Even on their beds they plot evil; they commit themselves to a sinful course and do not reject what is wrong.
⁵ Your love, LORD, reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies.
⁶ Your righteousness is like the highest mountains, your justice like the great deep. You, LORD, preserve both people and animals.
⁷ How priceless is your unfailing love, O God! People take refuge in the shadow of your wings.
⁸ They feast on the abundance of your house; you give them drink from your river of delights.
⁹ For with you is the fountain of life; in your light we see light. – Psalm 36 (NIV)

- Slowly and prayerfully invite God to help you to understand: (Perhaps focus on one or two a day.)
 - A healthy and freeing fear of him
 - A clear sense of yourself and your sin
 - A God-honoring tongue
 - Actions founded on wisdom and goodness
 - A mind fixed on and a commitment to God's will
 - Conviction to reject what is wrong
- As God shines light into areas of brokenness or disobedience, admit them, inviting Him to foster free and healthy obedience.
- How is God (vv.5-9) different from the wicked (vv.1-4)? Is there anything which strikes you in this description of God? Why?
- Pray through verses 5- 9, reflecting on your experiences of these characteristics? Invite God to show you His love, righteousness, justice, protection, provision, joy, or life in your life and the world? (Perhaps pray over one or two characteristics a day.)
- For one day this month, intentionally create reminders in your day of God's immensity, goodness, and activity in the world.
